





### **Q2** Do you agree with these objectives?





## Q3 On a scale of 0-100, how tranquil is the area where you live? (100=very tranquil)





### Q4 Do you have concerns about noise pollution in your locality?





### Q5 Do you have concerns about light pollution in your locality?





## **Q6** Do you think that our Neighbourhood Plan should identify, protect and where possible enhance local biodiversity?







## **Q8** Should we encourage the restoration of the Grantham Canal to make it navigable for boats?





### **Q9** Should Hickling Basin become a focal point for visits to the Grantham Canal?





### Q14 Where do you live?









### **Q24** How many bedrooms would that household expect to need?













# **Q47** Do you require additional business space in the next three years?








